Mary Harris Henry was the only member of her father and mother's family (Edward Harris and Lora Estes Harris) that did not migrate westward in 1845 into Georgia and then to Texas and Ark. by 1859. Mary lost all contact with her parents, sisters and brothers and for sixty years she looked in vain for some word from them. The writer contacted her Grandson in 1950. Found his name in a History of Haywood Co., N.C. He told me that my letter would have meant so much to his grandmother if it had come in her lifetime. Mary Harris was the oldest sister of my grandfather, Andrew Jackson Harris.

Dear Mrs. Jones:

As a friend and fellow officer of your brother Dan, I wish to express my deepest sympathy to you and the other members of his family for the sorrow which has come to you all recently.

He was one of the first officers I met in this regiment, and being from Arkansas (I'm from Fordyce) we had something in common from the start. We became good friends and since December had worked together in the same Company.

Dan was well liked and thought of by both enlisted men and officers of the regiment. As a regimental communications officer, he did an outstanding job and was slated for promotion. His death was a loss to the entire unit.

It happened several days after the 511 entered this operation. After a rapid thirty-one mile advance, the regiment encountered very heavy opposition. An artillery round landed in the two-story building which was being used as a regimental head-quarters. Dan was upstairs at the time. I had just entered the building. It may be of some small comfort to you to know that he suffered no pain.

I would have written to his wife, whom I also think a great deal of, but did not know her address. Incidentally, I got your address through a salesman of the Richie Grocery at Hope, Ark.

If there is anything I might be able to do for you here, please don't hesitate to notify me at any time.

Again, my deepest sympathy to all of you.
