Andrew Jackson Harris was born in Burke County, N.C. Migrated to Georgia with his family soon after 1845. The family was in the 1850 Census of Murray Co., Ga. Dicey Eveline Harris's father Giles N. Harris was also b. in Burke Co., N.C. Migrating with his family from Buncombe Co., N.C. before the 1840 Census into Gwinnert County, Ga. Dicey Eveline was b. in Murray Co., Ga. Her family and also that of her husband migrated in the same wagon train to Tex., some however settled in Hempstead Co., Ark.

Dicey Eveline Harris told her children that she remembered well their trip to Texas by wagon train. She was about nine years old at the time. They were nearly a year making the trip as the weather was very bad so much of the time. The men had to clear and make many of their roads. Often they would lose their fire and would have to make it to some settlers home and "borrow" fire.

Andrew Jackson Harris served in the Civil War. Confederate Records of Murray Co., Ga., now in the Archives at Atlanta, Ga., state that he received an Honorable Discharge in 1863 for disability-loss of lung.

They were among the early settlers of Wood Co. James Gilbert Harris, a brother of Giles N. Harris, blazed the way in 1852. He settled on the old Warlick place between Quitman and Oak Grove Community. The next year, 1853, David, his brother, their mother, Rebecca Gilbert Harris and their maiden sister, Dicy, along with others came. Among them was Temperance, a sister of the above men. She married Abraham Sudderth in Ga. They had four children at that time. She was taken ill on the trip, d. and was buried in the Mississippi Delta.

Jack (Andrew Jackson) Harris was a prosperous farmer and at his death had accumulated a considerable amount for that day and time. He owned a Cotton Gin, a Grist Mill and also freighted to and from Jefferson, Tex. which at that time was one of the main trading points in that part of Tex.

The Santa Fe Railroad extended its line from Canyon to Plainview in 1906. Harris's first business connection was with Fulton Lumber Co. They were opening a yard and A. J. Harris assisted in the construction of the first sheds. He later went with Rockwell Lumber Co. at Kress and after 8 years returned to Tulia where he went into business for himself as an independent dealer until his death May 15, 1957. A. J. Harris served as Mayor of Tulia from 1923 until 1925 and during that time The Tulia Municipal Light and Power Company was enlarged and remodeled. Both were reared in Tulia, Tex. and graduated in Tulia High School. Charles L. Harris attended Metropolitan Business College, Dallas, Tex. Kept books for Amarillo Sash and Door Co., Amarillo, Tex. He later went into the Glass Business for himself. He is a member of the Masonic Lodge, the Scottish Rite and is a Shriner. Gladys Spear Harris attended West Texas Teacher's College and taught for two years in the Silverton, Tex. public school. They were m. Mar. 18, 1934. Harris served in the Navy during World War II. He was stationed on the West Coast. Their home is 3514 Milam St., Amarillo, Tex. They have one son: (8) Dale Andrew Harris b. May 6, 1946.

(7) James Travis Harris b. Sept. 17, 1915, son of A. J. Harris, Jr. and Willie Maude Teurman Harris, m. Nov. 15, 1938 to Marie Zimmerman b. Dec. 10, 1915, dau. of Mr. and Mrs. Dennis Zimmerman. Both are graduates of Tulia High School. James T. Harris attended Metropolitan Business College, Dallas, Tex. He kept books for several years for his father in the A.J. Harris Lumber Co. After his father's death, he became owner and manager of the Yard. During World War II he served in the Navy, stationed on the West Coast. Marie Zimmerman Harris has a B.A. Degree from Technological College at Lubbock, Tex.

James Travis Harris was fatally injured on the 22nd of Aug. 1962. He was one of the Volunteer Firemen and was returning from a false alarm call about six miles north of Tulia. He was inside the City limits when a large trailer-truck, loaded with grain, pulled across the South bound lanes, stopped at the North bound lanes to wait for traffic and James T. Harris was too near to bring his car to a stop in time. He was killed instantly. He was a member of V.F.W., a Mason, the Scottish Rite in Dallas and belonged to a Shriner group in Amarillo. He went into service of United States during the Spanish American War and stayed in service most of the time until his death. He is buried at Fort Bayard, N.M. in the Government Cemetery.

(6) Henry Rossman Harris b. ca. 1882, d. cal 906, son of Andrew Jackson Harris, Sr. and Dicey Evelyn Harris, left home at 16. His brothers and sisters never heard from him more than twice after he left. It is surmised that he was killed in the San Francisco Earthquake in 1906 as last letter was from San Francisco about that time.

(5) William Benjamin Harris, son of Edward Harris and Lora Estes Harris b. Aug. 11, 1842, d. Apr. 8, 1911, m. 1st to Mary Arminda Harris, who was a sister of Dicey Eveline Harris, wife of Andrew Jackson Harris, brother to William Benjamin Harris. Mary Arminda Harris was b. 1842, d. Mar. 24, 1870. William Benjamin Harris came to Texas with other members of the family from Ga. in 1859. Mary Arminda Harris also came in the same wagon-train. William Benjamin Harris was b. in North Carolina. He settled in Wood Co., Oak Grove Community, and never lived any other place. They both are buried in the Ebenezer Cemetery, Oak Grove. There are markers at graves. Their children were: (6) Benjamin Wiley Harris b. Sept. 1, 1862, d. Nov. 1915, (6) Giles Miniard Harris b. Jan. 26, 1868, d. Jan. 1888.

Upon his completion of cadet training, he was assigned to the Japanese War theater as a fighter pilot and served in that theater from Guadalcanal to Iwo Jima. At the outbreak of the Koren conflict, he was assigned to foreign service as an executive officer of a Tactical Reconnaisance Air Base Group. He was later transferred for overseas duty at Chamblee, France. At the time of leaving service, Col. Denton was squadron Commander at Shepard Field, Wichita Falls, Tex. He was in service twenty years. On retiring from service, Harris L. Denton was employed by the Texas Education Rehabilitation Division as a Disability Determination Counselor. The writer has been unable to get very much information on the three daughters of Edward Harris, 1804-1869. They are: (3) Sena Harris b. 1836 in N.C. She was married to Lewis O'Rear in Ga. It is presumed that they migrated to Ark. in 1859 when other families were migrating Westward. They were in Rains Co. near Emory, Tex. later, about 1880. Their children were: (6) Thomas O'Rear, (6) Monroe O'Rear, (6) William O'Rear, (6) Mary O'Rear. Have no records of birth dates and if there were other children.

- (5) Rhoda Francis Harris b. 1845, eighth child of Edward Harris and Lora Estes Harris, m. John Sanford, near Ozan, Ark. Rhoda Francis (called Fannie) and Elizabeth Ann Harris were the only children not born in N.C. They were both born in Ga., Murray Co. Rhoda Francis (Fannie) Harris Sanford and John Sanford came to Texas about 1880 and settled in Rains Co., near Emory, Tex. Their children were: (6) James Sanford, (6) John Sanford, (6) Robert Sanford, (6) Katherine Sanford, (6) Twin girls, Sena and Mary Emily Sanford. No birth records or any information about this family.

They were members of the "Zion" Baptist Church in the country near Ozan, Ark. An old record was found of the church Minutes where they had withdrawn their letters in 1869. This possibly is about the time they migrated into Texas. If this is right, then there is a possibility that all three of the girls and their husbands migrated into Texas about the same time, about 1869. The writer thinks this must be right as my father knew them when he was a child and grew up with some of their children.
