

DICIA A. EVELYN HARRIS - 1851-1885

(5) Dicia America Evelyn Harris b. Feb. 27, 1851, d. Feb. 1885, dau. of Giles N. Harris and Emillier (Millie) Mason Whitworth Harris, m. 1868 to Andrew Jackson Harris, Sr., b. Oct. 21, 1839, N. C., d. Nov. 13, 1884. They are both buried in the Ebenezer Cemetery, Oak Grove Community, Wood Co., Tex. The graves have long ago disappeared, also markers. Dicia Eveline Harris and Andrew was b. in Murray Co., Ga. The parents of both Dicia Eveline Harris and Andrew Jackson Harris, with other members of the family migrated to Tex. and Ark. in 1859. Andrew Jackson Harris' parents settled in Ark. near Ozan, Hempstead Co. His sister Eveline Robins and husband John Bush Robins also went to Arkansas. Andrew Jackson Harris and brother William Benjamin came on to Tex. with Giles Harris. Shortly afterward Andrew Jackson went back to Murray Co. and enlisted to fight in the Civil War. He was injured at battle of Chicamauga. He lost one lung; was given an honorable discharge. Soon after his return to Texas he and Dicia Eveline were married.

Giles N. Harris's two younger brothers, James Gilbert and David blazed the way to Texas in 1852, settled in Wood Co. The next year David went back for his mother, Rebecca Gilbert Harris, and his maiden sister, Dicy, and while there a wagon-train of several members of the family decided to come along with them to Texas. All of the family settled in Wood Co. and were, of course, early pioneers of the county as well as of Texas.

Andrew Jackson Harris, called Jack, was a prosperous farmer and at his death had accumulated a considerable amount for that time. He owned a cotton-gin and a grist mill. He lost an arm in this gin. He also freighted by wagon and oxenteams to Jefferson, Tex. bringing back supplies from there. Jefferson was at that time one of the leading trading-posts in East Texas.
